The award is presented to individuals or institutions from business, politics, science, and culture from the United States and Germany in the realm of a gala dinner format.

Transatlantic Partnership Award: Past Awardees

In 2024, a distinguished jury chaired by AmCham Germany President Simone Menne has selected Ms. Margot Friedländer and Ms. Anna Winger, American writer, producer, and photographer, as the 2024 award recipients: Margot Friedländer for her tireless commitment to the positive coexistence of people and peace between peoples; and Anna Winger, as the inspiring creator and writer of historical and contemporary stories, for her great cinematic portrayal of the important relationships on both sides of the Atlantic.
