




1. What impact do you believe the U.S. elections will have on transatlantic relations as a whole?




2. What impact do you believe the U.S. elections will have on transatlantic business relations?

3. In which of the following transatlantic policy areas do you see the most need for action in the coming years?








4a. How likely do you view transatlantic cooperation in the following areas under the next U.S. administration?



4b. How likely do you view transatlantic cooperation in the following areas under the next U.S. administration?


• Coordinated security and defense policies





4c. How likely do you view transatlantic cooperation in the following areas under the next U.S. administration?


• A united U.S.-EU approach to China

• Reductions in greenhouse gas emissions and support for renewable energy




5. Which issues do you believe the German government should prioritize in order to strengthen Germany's competitiveness? (1/2)




Improve the quality of education
